Banking of AM Part II Exam

Trainees are required to pass the two components of Part II Examination, i.e. both the training theses assessment and the oral examination before being deemed to be successful. This is a pre-requisite before trainees can proceed to take the Exit examination.

If only one component of the Part II Examination is given a pass, it is possible to bank the 'passed' component and the candidate will only need to be examined in the 'failed' component in the next sitting. The bankability of the 'passed' component is limited to 12 months. This is illustrated below: -

Pass	Fail	Actions
Theses	Oral	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bank theses for 1 year• Retake oral in next sitting
Oral	Theses	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bank oral for 1 year• Retake theses in next sitting
